Guidelines for Working on Catholic Religious Scout Emblems

- Each Scout should have a booklet. Complete the activities in the book as suggested. Many activities from Religious Education Classes relate to these programs.
- When the book is completed, ask your Pastor or Deacon to meet with the youth to review the activities and sign the application page. This can be done individually or as a group.
- Mail the application page to the Catholic Scouting office with the application fee of \$2.00 before the ceremony deadline.
- Make checks payable to and mail to :

- The booklet can be completed any time during the appropriate scouting level. If for some reason the Scout cannot attend the ceremony of the year the award was completed, the Scout can receive the award the following year.

Requirements for Catholic Scouting Emblems: Standards for each of these programs have been prepared by the National Committee on Scouting. No Changes are permitted.

To Receive an Emblem: All emblems are to be received at the annual Religious Awards Ceremony.
NO MEDALS ARE SENT OUT FOR LOCAL PRESENTATION.
